Abstracts should include the following elements: (1) the name and surname of the author(s), (2) the affiliation of the author(s), (3) the email address(es) of the author(s), (4) the title of the presentation, and (5) within 100-150 words: the aims, methodology and expected results of the project to be reported in the presentation.

Abstracts should be sent electronically, as email attachments in Microsoft Word **.doc format**, to the Conference's email address: **elalt.novisad@gmail.com**, with the word 'abstract' as the subject.

Abstracts will be evaluated according to the **originality** of the theme, approach and scholarly contribution of the proposal.

Deadline for the submission of abstracts: **31 October 2010**.

Deadline for the notification of acceptance: **31 December 2010**.
